- b) approve a change in pest management methodology for the Hönua Ranges regional parklands, to the aerial application of sodium-fluoroacetate (1080), to commence in mid-2015  
c) note that best practice guidelines for this activity will be followed including the National Pest Control Agencies' Aerial 1080 Pest Control Industry Guidelines and the Environmental Risk Management Authority's Communications Guideline for Aerial 1080 Operations  
d) note that this decision is specific to the Hönua Ranges regional parklands. Use of this methodology in other areas would need to be considered on a case by case basis specific to each site  
e) approve the establishment of a political advisory group consisting of Councillors Wood, Darby, Cashmore, Cooper, Fletcher, W Walker, Mr Malcolm Bell Franklin Local Board member and one IMSB member, to work with staff in the planning and implementation phase of the aerial application of 1080 in the Hönua Ranges.
